14/016 Apologies for Absence

The Council were asked if there were any apologies for absence.

14/017 Co-option

14/019 Declaration of Interest

Resolved: No declarations of interest were raised.

14/020 Minutes

The Chairman asked the Council members to consider the minutes of the last meeting held on Tuesday 13th May 2014. Bernard Parker's name did not appear on the list of those present and the record was amended accordingly. The council members were then asked to consider the draft minutes of the annual parish meeting and it was agreed that they were a true reflection of the annual meeting.
